### Fan Pier building opens with dancers in the sky

The Fallon Co. officially opened its latest Fan Pier project, 100 Northern Ave., with a party on Thursday evening that featured dancers rappelling down the 17-story building's facade.

The 516,000-square-foot building will be home to the international law firm [Goodwin Procter LLP](#), whose 800 employees will move to the custom-built tower from 53 State St. on June 27.

The kick-off event featured remarks from Boston economic development chief [John Barros](#), state Rep. [Nick Collins](#), Goodwin Procter Boston office chair [Andy Sucoff](#), and Fallon Co. founder [Joe Fallon](#).

In his speech, Sucoff thanked former Goodwin chairman [Regina Pisa](#) for having the vision years ago to choose the Seaport as Goodwin's new home. "There's a palpable sense of excitement throughout the ranks of Goodwin as we prepare to move into our waterfront home," Sucoff said.

To mark the occasion, Fallon tapped Bandaloop, a "vertical dance" troupe, to perform on the side of the building.
