Ground-breaking on tap for Fan Pier luxury condo tower

A Wednesday ground-breaking ceremony is scheduled for Twenty Two Liberty, which is billed as Boston's first water-view luxury condo project since 2009.

The project developer is [The Fallon Co.](#) According to a Fallon Co. media advisory, Twenty Two Liberty is a 14-story, luxury residential tower situated at [Fan Pier](#) on Boston's Waterfront.

Encompassing nine city blocks and 21 acres of space, Fan Pier is a large mixed-use development project; on completion, it will be made up of eight buildings. There will be offices, residences, retail and a hotel, as well as a public park and full service marina, Fallon Co. said

Among the dignitaries expected to join Fallon Co. president and chief executive Joseph F. Fallon are Mayor Thomas M. Menino, Massachusetts State Senator Linda Dorcea Forry, Massachusetts State Representative Nick Collins, and Boston City Councillor Bill Linehan, the advisory said.
